

## CCE English Learner Program 2020-21

### Notes for ELAC and Site Council Presentation –Jan. 2021

#### Current Numbers

- 28 total EL students this year, 1 with a waiver from services
- 21 RFEP students to monitor (reclassified students are monitored for 4 years)
- 2 dual-identified students (EL Students with an IEP)

#### ELPAC Data from Spring 2019 (current EL proficiency levels)

- 4 Novice or Level 1 Students
- 13 Intermediate or Level 2 Students
- 7 Level 3 Students
- 0 Level 4 or Advanced Students
- 16 current EL students took the ELPAC in the spring of 2018 and again in the spring of 2019.  
Of those 16:
  - 2 students went up 1 level
  - 9 students went up 2 levels
  - 0 students remained in the same level over both years
  - 5 students went down 1 ELPAC level
  - 0 student went down 2 ELPAC levels

#### Initial ELPAC data Fall 2020 (17 incoming students who reported a language other than English on their home language survey)

- Initial ELPAC scores:
  - 16 Initial Kinder and 1 Initial 1<sup>st</sup> grade ELPAC exams given 1-on-1
    - 4 Novice Students (ELs)
    - 13 Initially Fluent English Proficient (IFEP)

#### 17 Languages spoken by current EL Students:

- 22 Spanish
- 2 Mandarin
- 1 Cantonese
- 1 Korean

#### EL Services

- Kinder: 30 minutes per day, 2x/week (Mondays and Thursdays)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> grades: 30 minutes per day 2x/week
- 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> grade: 45 minutes per day 1x/week

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
