Current Numbers

- 28 total EL students this year, 1 with a waiver from services
- 21 RFEP students to monitor (reclassified students are monitored for 4 years)
- 2 dual-identified students (EL Students with an IEP)

ELPAC Data from Spring 2019 (current EL proficiency levels)

- 4 Novice or Level 1 Students
- 13 Intermediate or Level 2 Students
- 7 Level 3 Students
- 0 Level 4 or Advanced Students
- 16 current EL students took the ELPAC in the spring of 2018 and again in the spring of 2019. Of those 16:
 - 2 students went up 1 level
 - o 9 students went up 2 levels
 - 0 students remained in the same level over both years
 - o 5 students went down 1 ELPAC level
 - 0 student went down 2 ELPAC levels

<u>Initial ELPAC data Fall 2020</u> (17 incoming students who reported a language other than English on their home language survey)

- Initial ELPAC scores:
 - o 16 Initial Kinder and 1 Initial 1st grade ELPAC exams given 1-on-1
 - 4 Novice Students (ELs)
 - 13 Initially Fluent English Proficient (IFEP)
